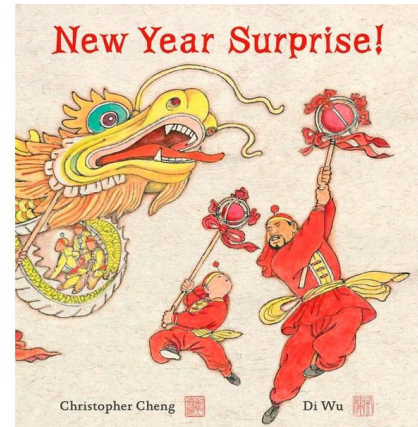

Make your own Chinese New Year lanterns

What you need:

- Red A4 paper
- Sticky tape
- Hole punch
- Scissors
- String or ribbon

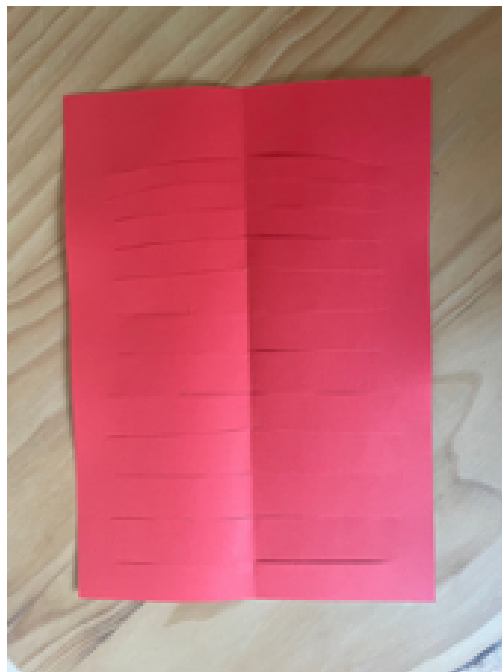
Instructions:

1. Fold your page in half vertically.
2. Cut along the folded edge at 1 - 2 cm intervals. Do not cut all the way through.
3. Once you have cut your paper, open it back out and gently connect the two shorter sides of the paper. Secure these sides together with some sticky tape.
4. Use a hole punch to create two holes at the top of your lantern and thread a piece of ribbon or string through the holes.
5. Hang your lantern somewhere in your home!
